

## MONROE JULY 8TH SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: (Informal)

### The Start:

We will start at the Chicago Lighthouse on a line between the lighthouse and the green marker on the south . The start will be between 19:00 and 19:15. There will be no signals or flags. You can start anytime during that window. Each boat shall log their start time as noted on their GPS. Monitor channel 69 for any courtesy broadcasts.

### The Course:

The course will be start at the Chicago Lighthouse, Round Four-Mile Crib leaving it and all safety buoys to starboard. finish at the south end of the breakwall.

### The Finish:

The finish line will be at the south end of the outer breakwall, on an infinite line extending due south from the red marker. Each boat shall log their finish time as noted on their GPS.

### Finish report:

Please email your finish report to [regattamanager@chicagoyachtclub.org](mailto:regattamanager@chicagoyachtclub.org) and [dieball@chicagoyachtclub.org](mailto:dieball@chicagoyachtclub.org) no later than 10:00 am on July 9th. The finish report shall contain: Boat Name, boat number, boat type, PHRF rating, elapsed time, and an email address for notification.

### Scoring/Awards:

There will be one winner overall. She shall receive a bottle of Rum which will be awarded at CYC Monroe Station, following the normally scheduled race on 7/15. We will notify finishing boats via email of results. This race does not count toward any series.
